Scope

- The European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT) and five of its Knowledge & Innovation Communities (KICs) have launched the **EIT Community Booster**, a joint initiative to support innovative ventures and teams enabling the New European Bauhaus (NEB) transformation
- EIT Community Booster targets the most innovative start-ups and scale-ups driving sustainable change for cities, industries, climate, food, wellbeing and overall quality of life to support their business growth and help them become international gamechangers
- The 20 best companies will benefit with a total support services package collectively worth 1 million Euro





Scope

- Five support programmes for different thematic areas from EIT Knowledge & Innovation Communities
- €50 000 for every start-up supported - support ranges from grants to business support services

Programmes include the following services:

- ✓ Tailored access to finance
- ✓ Training, coaching, mentoring,
- ✓ Communications/ visibility support
- ✓ Access to the EIT Community network
- ✓ Tailored market support (reaching new customers)
- ✓ Access to facilities such as labs, pilot sites, test beds

Target audience

EIT Climate-KIC	Start-ups developing innovative projects for the renewable energy industry, mobility, green spaces and retrofitting, contributing to more sustainable, healthy and clean cities
EIT Digital	Scale-ups leveraging the power of digital transformation to create innovative solutions and products across industries
EIT Food	Agri-food startups making a big impact on any part of the agriculture or food supply
EIT Manufacturing	Start-ups enabling green and socially sustainable manufacturing, fostering long term, life cycle and integrated thinking in the industrial ecosystem
EIT Urban Mobility	Start-ups developing sustainable alternatives for hardscapes as urban spaces, biodiversity, enhancing public realm and accessibility



Eligibility criteria

EIT Climate-KIC	already have PoC/Alpha/Beta/prototype, less than 5 years old;
EIT Digital	Incorporated after 01/01/2011; min. €300 k annual revenue (2020) OR 2MEUR of total funding;
EIT Food	customer validation, early traction, technology readiness
EIT Manufacturing	operative for more than one year, have a dedicated full-time team
EIT Urban Mobility	validated technology, min 1 billion addressable market, min 2 FTEs, less than €1M revenue (lifetime), at least 70% of company is owned by founders & employees

- Headquarter is based in the EU 27 or in one of the Horizon Europe associated countries
- Financial Sustainability mechanism expected

1. Green transition through architectural, cultural, and historic sites:

- Natural building materials and energy efficiency, including refurbishment of existing, historic buildings.
- Sustainable alternatives for hardscapes as urban spaces, naturalisation of degraded public areas, green areas, biodiversity, green and blue infrastructures, and urban furniture as assets promoting active mobility, improving citizen well-being, and mitigating heat island effects.
- Urban farming and regenerative agriculture to reduce emissions and foster the relationship between city and farmer.

2. Towards circularity and urban resilience:

- Enhancement of public realm, accessibility, and interconnection through active mobility modalities, to mitigate air pollution and noise, and improve physical and mental health.

3. Ensuring affordability and accessibility to all:

- Energy communities to ensure comfort living at affordable prices through multidisciplinary retrofitting teams.
- Shift from building-centric to community-centric approach in providing telecommunications, data, energy, water, waste.
- Upgrade historic and old buildings to meet new energy efficiency requirements whilst preserving their significance and sense of belonging within the community.
- Universal mobility as a key enabler for social inclusion. Everyone should be able to move freely within cities regardless gender, race, beliefs, or disability (barrier free access).

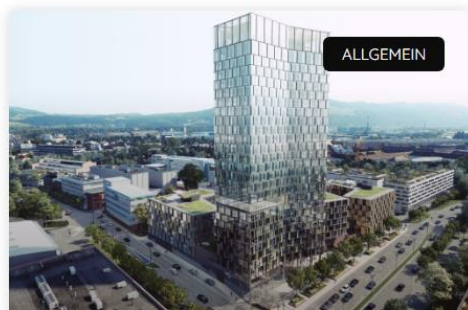

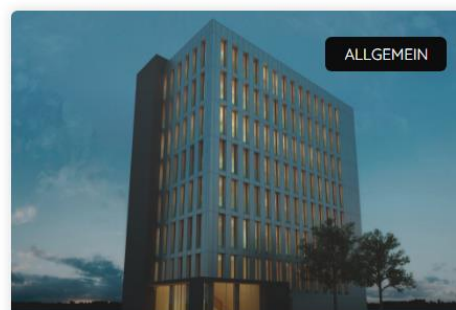
